

Year R Autumn 1 Project: Hello! It's Me



In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we are learning to:

- show friendly behaviour to others by talking and playing
- feel confident to talk to others
- ask for help
- recognise our feelings and how to be kind to others

In Communication and Language we are learning to:

- follow simple instructions e.g. to get or put away an object.
- sustain our attention for short periods of time
- understand preposition words such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting correct picture.
- Explore new vocabulary (e.g. the language of our Learning Superheroes)

In Physical Development we are learning to:

- move in different ways—shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping.
- draw large lines and circles.
- make marks on paper using pencils, pens, crayons etc.
- manage going to the toilet independently.
- wash and dry our hands independently.

In Literacy we are learning to:

- join in with rhyming activities
- hear and say words that begin with the same sound e.g. sock and snake, bear and ball
- listen to poems and stories.
- hold books correctly, turning the pages and reading words from left to right and from top to bottom
- make marks on paper and give meaning to them.

In Maths we are learning to:

- say number names in order to 10 and beyond
- count sets of objects and match a numeral to it up to 10
- recognise numerals 0-10
- count out objects from a set.
- find, name and talk about shapes in the environment.
- use positional language such as over, under, above.

In Expressive Arts and Design we are learning to:

- sing lots of familiar songs.
- explore the sounds of different instruments.
- mix colours together.
- make up simple dances
- make up stories in play e.g. setting up a café, using toys to tell a story (dinosaurs, animals, dolls house)

In Understanding the World we are learning to:

- talk about important people and places in their life.
- talk about events in their own life e.g. birthdays, nursery.
- look at pictures of events from their own life e.g. when they were babies, toddlers etc.
- have a go on PurpleMash on the computer.
