

Year R Autumn 2 Project: Let's Party!



In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we are learning to:

- initiate conversation and listen to what other people say
- describe self in positive terms
- be aware of our own feelings and know that some actions and words can hurt others

In Communication and Language we are learning to:

- follow simple instructions e.g. to get or put away an object.
- sustain our attention for short periods of time in a group
- beginning to understand 'how' and 'why' questions
- use language to recreate roles and experiences in play situations

In Physical Development we are learning to:

- build hand strength and develop our finger isolation
- improve our hand eye coordination
- build strength in our core muscles including shoulder stability, elbow and wrist movements for writing.
- show increased control over an object by pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it.

In Literacy we are learning to:

- continue a rhyming string e.g. cat, mat...hat
- recognise phase 2 sounds and use them to read simple words such as sat, pat, pin
- To orally blend words for reading e.g. m-a-t...mat
- To orally segment words for spelling e.g. dog...d-o-g
- Write our name and other things such as labels and captions

In Maths we are learning to:

- represent numbers 1-5
- compare numbers 1-5
- explore how numbers are made up of other numbers to 5
- to explore 1 more and 1 less
- to recognise 2d shapes, circle, triangle, square and rectangle
- Understand about routines and times of the day

In Expressive Arts and Design we are learning to:

- learn lots of familiar songs.
- explore tempo—fast and slow and keeping to a steady beat
- Manipulate clay and use tools safely
- copy a simple dance routine to music
- To add a storyline to our play

In Understanding the World we are learning to:

- talk about some of the similarities and differences in relation to friends or family
- join in with family customs and routines
- use a simple program on Busy Things
